



## How to fill in this sheet:

<b>G...P...+</b>	Gravida= number of times pregnant ... Parity= number of pregnancies that go beyond 24 weeks ... + number of pregnancies that terminate before that time (either miscarriage or abortion)
<b>Address</b>	Please fill in the address if your patient wishes to be written to with results
<b>GP address</b>	Please fill in this address if patient wishes GP/primary care provider to receive copy of her results
<b>Date</b>	Date patient attended
<b>Wt (kg)</b>	Weight in kg
<b>LMP</b>	Last menstrual period or withdrawal bleed
<b>BP</b>	Blood pressure in mmHg
<b>Smoker?</b>	Record 'current' or 'ex' or 'never'
<b>Injecting drug use (IDU)</b>	Record 'current' or 'ex' or 'never'
<b>Contraception</b>	Record current method of contraception i.e. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• NSA (not sexually active)</li> <li>• 'none' (sexually active but not using contraception)</li> <li>• 'condoms'</li> <li>• 'POP' (progestogen only pill)</li> <li>• 'CHC' (combined hormonal contraception: pill, patch or ring)</li> <li>• 'depo' (depo provera injectable contraception)</li> <li>• 'implant'</li> <li>• 'IUS or 'IUD'</li> <li>• 'post menopausal' (record if taking hormone replacement therapy HRT)</li> </ul>
<b>Aware of EHC?</b>	Record that patient knows about emergency hormonal contraception if using condoms for her main method
<b>ARVs taken?</b>	You must ask about antiretrovirals (especially PIs) and other enzyme-inducers, as may affect contraceptive and HRT efficacy
<b>CD4 count</b>	Record latest CD4 count
<b>Partner status</b>	Record if 'HIV neg' 'HIV pos' 'untested' 'not known/not discussed'
<b>Cervical smear</b>	Record if taken and record result i.e. (UK grading) negative, borderline, mild (CIN1), moderate (CIN2), severe (CIN3) +/- HPV
<b>Colposcopy result</b>	Record if colposcopy was 'adequate' (ie squamous columnar junction seen) or 'inadequate' (i.e. SCJ not seen) Plus the degree of abnormality seen (UK grading) 'NAD' 'CIN1' 'CIN2' 'CIN3' 'MICRO' or 'HPV'
<b>Biopsy taken</b>	Record if taken and result when available
<b>HVS</b>	High vaginal swab (record if taken and result when available)
<b>Endo</b>	Endocervical swab (record if taken and result when available)
<b>Chlam</b>	Chlamydia swab (record if taken and result when available)
<b>Other investigations</b>	E.g. record if you carry out pregnancy test, ultrasound scan, herpes viral swab. Record any treatment given
<b>Follow up</b>	Record the date recommended for next smear or colposcopy, or next follow up for other issues
