## JUSTRI PrEP Training

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Turkey is in the process of developing a PrEP roll-out programme and Dr Deniz Gökengin of Ege University in Izmir asked JUSTRI to provide a training both in person and online for HCPs who will be involved in this process, and we were happy to oblige.

The meeting was held with her support and that of AIDS VE CYBH DERNEGI (AIDS and STD Association) a local NGO and was supported by Gilead Sciences and Pharmactive Pharmaceuticals. This was our first training on PrEP, but since then we have been asked for a follow-up event, to be held in Antalya, Turkey in November. In 2023 we will organise a similar meeting in Romania, where PrEP roll-out is also being planned.

For this training, the linkage with the in-country HIV doctors, whom we know very well, served to make the process simple, and they helped to promote the event through their own local institutions and colleagues. The meeting was held at the Anemon Ege Hotel and there were 23 attendees on-site and 135 on-line who included, infectious disease/HIV doctors and nurses and representatives of the HIV NGO. The morning session began with an overview of PrEP given virtually by Dr Laura Waters, followed by Deniz, who presented the aspirations for PrEP provision in Turkey. After the break a review of PrEP

implementation was provided by Dr Nadia Ahmed from London who has worked on such projects in South Africa. With excellent translators the audience were well engaged asked very insightful questions. The slides from the meeting with pictures, comments and more details are at <http://www.justri.org> . In the afternoon a smaller group convened who aim to spearhead the roll-out programme and in this session three groups consider a range of subjects such as demand creation, laboratory and pharmacy services and monitoring of the process. After feeding back their suggestions Nadia reviewed and critiqued the discussion and findings and so a process was begun which

will be developed in the roundtable later in the year.

This project re-enforced our view that localised and specific trainings on subjects such as PrEP can be highly effective at providing information and guidance on subjects of relevance in countries of Southeast Europe and that this can help those working locally to evolve new interventions to prevent HIV transmission. In this endeavour it is vital to engage a wide range of medical and allied health practitioners, as well as NGOs to produce an effective response and the feedback from the meeting was that we achieved this.
